

Other Options for Tax Customers

1. Wait until next year:
 - A. If Income Tax – go to a site and both years can be filed.
 - B. If MIPR (Renters Rebate or Property Tax Rebate) only – call in May 2018 to schedule an appointment for both years.

2. Prepare + Prosper prepares taxes free through October 24th, 2017

3. Find a paid preparer in the area.
 - A. Big name tax prep services tend to charge more
 - B. Small, locally owned business w/one employee would most likely be the cheapest.
Can call around for the best deal. use yellow pages or internet search.

4. Prepare returns yourself.
 - A. For renter’s rebates or homeowners property tax rebates, you can go to the Minnesota Revenue website (<http://www.revenue.state.mn.us>) to print and fill out forms and mail them in **or** fill them in online and print out to mail. Homeowners only can also complete the form online and submit it electronically right at the website.
 - B. If you need to complete Income taxes, you can use the “My Free Taxes” link on the Tri-CAP website under the taxes program to file your taxes using this free online service. The tax year income eligibility for this option is \$64,000 or less.
 - C. If you need to complete Income Taxes, you can access forms to print and fill in or fill in online and print to be mailed in on both the Minnesota Revenue and IRS websites. (<http://www.revenue.state.mn.us>) (www.irs.gov)
